Sep 1831	Alfred Abbott and Ann Collins	Married	Marriage was in Saint Johns Church <u>Parramatta</u>
Feb 1834	Alfred Abbott	Certificate of Freedom Granted	Alfred was now a free person and could move around without restriction.

1834-1836	Ann Collins	Apprehended	Ann must have been returned to her husband Alfred Abbott as their first child was born in 1836
19 Aug 1836	William Henry Abbott	Born	Penrith NSW – (Williams son Alfred John's birth certificate notes William was born in Penrith) Parents were Alfred and Ann Abbot.
11 Sep 1836	William Henry Abbott	Baptised (son)	Parish of Saint James <u>Sussex Street Sydney</u> Parents – Frederick Abbot and Ann Abbot (Williams Baptism Certificate)
1836	Alfred Abbott	Occupation	Bricklayer – (son William's baptism certificate)
31 Dec 1837	Alfred Abbott	Resided	Sydney – (wife's Convict Muster)
31 Dec 1837	Ann Collins	Resided	Sydney – (Convict Muster)
Dec 1838	Ann Collins	Ticket of Leave – Granted	This allowed Ann to stay in the District of <u>Sydney</u>
1836-1839	Alfred Abbott	Occupation – Soldier	Alfred must have enlisted as a Soldier between 1836 and 1839 as per his daughter Selina's baptism certificate noting this occupation.

1838-1839 About this time the name ANN ABBOTT (nee Collins) ceases to appear on any family related documents and Alfred wifes name changes and appears as: Emilia Abbot, Amelia Clark, Amelia Anne Clarkson, Emelia Jane Clarkson, Amelia Anne Sophia Clarkson, Amelia Sophia Clarke, Amelia Clarkson.

15 Oct 1838	AMELIA CLARK	Marriage	An Amelia Clark married a Francis Willis on the 15 Oct 1838 at Richmond NSW. Francis Willis death registered in 1840. No children known.
28 Dec 1838	ANN COLLINS – received her Ticket of Leave on the 28 Dec 1838 which only allowed her to live in Sydney....

31 Mar 1839	Selina Abbott	Baptised	Parish of Castlereagh in Cumberland NSW Parents were Alfred and Emilia
31 Mar 1839	Alfred Abbot / Emilia Abbot /	Resided	<u>Emu Plain</u> (Daughter Selina’s baptism certificate)

ANN COLLINS APPEARS AGAIN –

1845-1847        Ann Collins - Recommendation for Conditional Pardon - The persons who recommended the CP were Justices of the Peace from the Penrith  
and Maitland area, J. Cox JP, R Lethbridge JP and L? Dulhunty JP.

1847            Ann Collins - Conditional Pardon Granted - Conditional Pardons freed convicts and were granted on the condition that convicts did not return  
to England or Ireland.

1847            Ann Collins            NO FURTHER MENTION OF THIS NAME

1848            Alfred Abbott            Resided            Camperdown (unclaimed Letter - Newspaper)  
Occupation            Bricklayer

1856-57        Edward Abbott            Born (Son)            Birth Place – Petersham / Leichhardt

certificates)

1857            Alfred Abbott            Died / Age - 53            Liverpool Hospital

**WHERE DID THE CHILDREN OF ALFRED ABBOTT LIVE AFTER HE PASSED AWAY ?**

Son William Henry was living in Camperdown at the time of his marriage in 1858 aged 22.

Daughter Selina was living with relations in Concord just prior to her marriage in 1858 aged 19. I assume that the relations were William Henry Abbott and  
his wife Elizabeth as they were witnesses to her marriage and were residing in Concord.

Son Alfred George was aged 15 at the time of his fathers death.

Son John Nelson was aged 14 at the time of his fathers death.

Son Edward was aged 0 to 2 at the time of his fathers death.

Mother should be traceable up to at least 1857.
